himself are full and correct to the best of his  
 knowledge and belief.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: domestic purposes and watering stock throughout all the year.

(21) The character of the soil is gravelly and loam The soil needs 3 acre-feet (Sandy, gravelly, loam) per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Claimant was born and has lived on these lands all his life; his father, Domingo Lausirica, purchased the possessory right about thirty two years ago; that during all times since birth claimant has lived on said lands with his father and mother. That he and his said father have used all the water from Porcupone Creek and the springs on the said lands each and every year; that there are no surplus water in Porcupine Creek and it has never flowed into Tony Creek. That the maximum flow from the creek and spring is only sufficient for the land in cultivation.


