Remarks: The dam for impounding water is about 12 ft. high and 40 ft. long. The reservoir when full is about 100 ft. in diameter. The dam is of earth against a hand placed rock wall.

This dam is said to have been built by indians at an indefinite period, but since 1890 claimant has kept it in repair and has used the water impounded for watering his livestock. The spring is in the bed of the reservoir, but the principal supply of water comes from run-off of precipitation from the exposed bedrock drainage area above the dam.

The reservoir is located in some low rock buttes on the east edge of Bell Flat in Churchill County, Nevada.

Remarks: From a point on the dam, about its center:-

Buffalo Peak bears N. 87° 42' E.

Lodi Peak (near Illinois Mine) bears S. 45° 53' E.

Fairview Peak bears N. 24° 04' W.

Mt. Ahma bears S. 11° 57' W.
