

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From Poison Creek and Thunderbolt Creek, a Tributary.

Elizabeth Symonds Whitty, the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by her and her  
predecessors in interest are full and correct to the best of her  
knowledge and belief.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about 1868.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 30.52 acres.

(16) The water claimed has ~~has not~~ been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.  
Strike out one not wanted

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were None -  
If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration

of non-use should be given, appending a sheet if necessary

(18) The claimant's water right was ~~was not~~ recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

Washoe County, said record being at page 316 of Book "C" of

Surveys, and being a claim for all water of ~~Parson and~~

Thunderbolt and <sup>Cañon Springs</sup> Big of water for the irrigation of (acreage not named)

S.D. Woods and C.H. Symonds. (no other description)

NOTE—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (19)

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic use and watering stock throughout the year.

(21) The character of the soil is Porous gravelly loam. The soil needs 5.45 acre-feet (Sandy, gravelly, loam) per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 9 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: One cubic-foot per second would yield 5.45 acre-feet per acre in 9 months, but about 60 percent of this is needed during the months of May, June and July, with a maximum month's requirement being about 25 percent of that for the season, thus the mean required flow for 3 months would be about 1.80 second-feet, and that for the month of maximum requirement about 2.25 cubic-feet per second, for 100 acres.

All of the water furnished by Poison Creek and its tributary, Thunderbolt, has always been used, except during heavy freshets occurring at rare intervals, and the supply is always short in the late summer.
