(20) Remarks: *The waters of Big Square Creek and Tributaries was first used by applicant or its grantors in the year 1876 for agricultural and milling purposes, such claim being made of record in Book "A" of water rights of The Mount Cary Mining District, Esmeraldo County Nevada, as shown by the records of the Office of County Recorder of Esmeraldo County. Sometime prior to 1881 the manner of use of water was changed from agricultural purposes and a pipeline installed for conveying water into the town of Hawthorne where it was used for municipal and milling purposes. Such use has been continuous up to the present time. In 1929 in order to conserve and eliminate loss in transit the pipeline was extended for a distance of 8622 ft. up stream.*
