
(20) Remarks: The water from American Flat Creek was used for running a stamp mill until about 1900, also for milling by Greeley French. At that time he leased his property to R.A. Trimble who used the water for milling & cyaniding. About 1906 Capt. Davis acquired the property and he used it until 1908. At that time he sold out to Wm. Donovan who used the water for milling & cyaniding until 1918. In 1918 the property was sold to Wm. M. Donovan, the present owner, who has used the water continuously ever since that time.


