and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 180 days during

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

At least 2000 head of cattle were watered
from these springs during feeding periods of at least
Six months duration

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
one cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(11) The works are located at $SW\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, T. 36 N., R. 40 E.

Remarks: In 1891 Louis Dutertre constructed a ditch from the Golconda
Hot Springs to the Ranch through the land in Sec. 29 & 30 T. 36 N.
R. 40 E. and thereafter the water was continuously conveyed
across the ranch in a Northwesterly direction during the
Fall and Winter months for stock watering purposes.
The stock are watered in Secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30, T. 36 N., R. 40 E. of MDB&M.
Through the same ditches used for irrigation in summer months.
Headgates are as shown on map to regulate water.

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
