

 PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION



From INDIAN SPRINGS Name of natural water source

Earl Simpson, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by himself and his grantors are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 24"

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: domestic

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 6 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 9 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.


