(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Number of stock watered in successive years has varied, 100 cattle from 1895 to 1910. In 1910 in addition to watering 50 head of cattle, 2000 sheep were watered. Use changed in year 1913 to Angora Goats and from 1930 to 2000 head on the average watered every year to date.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been .025 cubic feet per second. or sufficient to water 100 cattle and 2000 goats.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N. 23° 44' W. 13.607 feet from the U.S. Mineral Monument No. 173. True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance This spring is situated in unsurveyed the SE corner of Section T. 12 N., R. 20 E.

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
