STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Yellow Spring Name of natural water course

Through small diversion dam, pipe line and watering troughs Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Charles Keough, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Charles Keough and predecessors in interest are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Number of stock watered in successive years has varied, 100 dattle fr
1895 to 1910. In 1910 in addition to watering 50 head of cattle, 2000
sheep were watered. Use changed in year 1923 to Angora Goats and from
1000 to 2000 head on the average watered every year to date.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
or sufficient to water 100 cattle and
1025 cubic feet per second. 2000 Goats.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 21° 33' E. 7,504 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the S. E. corner of Section 33, T. 7N., R. 36 E. E.

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
