and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during  
each of the following months January 1st to Dec. 31 of each year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Number of stock watered in successive years has varied, 100 cattle from 1895 to 1910. In 1910 in addition to watering 50 head of cattle, 2000 sheep were watered. Use changed in year 1923 to Angora goats and from 1000 to 2000 head on the average watered every year to date.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been .025 or sufficient to water 100 cattle and 2000 Goats cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 8° 20' E. 11,415.0 feet from the S.E. corner of Section 33, T. 7 N., R. 36 E.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at 150 Feet west of the point of diversion.
