


THE STATE OF NEVADA  
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR  
STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Green Spring .....  
Name of natural water course

Through a ditch (no name) to reservoir .....  
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

James Hunter ....., the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by  
him ..... are full and correct to the  
best of his knowledge and belief.

About 100 head cattle and horses graze in that vicinity more  
less during the months previously mentioned.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
about 1/20 cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 18° 40' E., 2,430 feet feet from  
the North West corner of Section 14, T. 19 N., R. 54 E. E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at about 300 feet Easterly of the point of diversion  
in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  section 14 T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.


