duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by them, are full and correct to the best of their

knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant Charles E., and Lena E. McLeod.

(2) The means of diversion employed open ditch. Dam, and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was July 23rd and 27th., 1943

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1885. and completed prior to 1885.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 20 inches, feet, width on top 2.5 feet, depth 14 feet, on a grade of 10 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. NOTE-If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is/has) an owner in the above-described conduit.

(11) Crops of alfalfa and hay have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from 1885 to of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or grantors in the year 1885 when 22.18 acres were irrigated in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4 of Sec. 1, T. 11 N., R. 45 E., M.D.M.,

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: watering stock and domestic purposes.

(21) The character of the soil is sandy. The soil needs one acre-foot
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of six months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.
