- (20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock watering and domestic purposes

(21) The character of the soil is loam. The soil needs 5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one (1) cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of eight (8) months from March 1 to October 1 of each year and a continuous flow of .33 cubic feet of water per second during the irrigation season of four (4) months from October 1st of one year until March 1st of the next year, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Cane Springs Creek Stream System, including Cane Springs and Creek leading therefrom, constitute a stream system. This stream system is found in Township 39 N., Range 27 E., and flows in a general southerly direction. Since 1880 all of the waters of this stream system have been used beneficially on the lands now belonging to claimant. This use includes irrigation, stock watering and domestic use throughout the entire year, although the amount used fluctuates depending in part on the season and existing flow. This use started as early as 1880, and at all times since has been continuously developed and beneficially used. All of the water was so beneficially used at least as early as 1880. Since long prior to 1880 the livestock watered at this stream system have been in sufficient numbers to utilize substantially all that portion of the public range readily available to livestock watering at said Cane Springs Creek stream system. Vested rights are claimed.
