KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, E. G. Stevenson of the County of Storey and State of aforesaid and owner of all of Section 5 in Township 16 North, Range 20 E., M.D.B. & M., containing 640 acres of land and situated in said county of Washoe, do hereby certify and declare that I desire and intend to construct and maintain a dam across a certain stream flowing from a canon running westerly and southerly through Sections 1,2,11 and 10 and said stream flowing from said canon at or near the line dividing said sections 2 and 11 in said Township and range and running northwesterly and westerly through said Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 for the purpose of holding and conveying the waters of said canon and stream through a flume by me to be constructed and maintained from said dam to the lands in said section 5 for irrigation and other purposes; as shown by the annexed plat, which is made a part hereof. Said flume shall be known as the Stevenson Flume and is with the dam to be constructed and maintained under the provisions of the Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, approved March 3, 1866, entitled "An Act to allow any person or persons to divert the waters of any river or stream, etc." I hereby claim all the waters flowing through said canon, to be held and diverted as aforesaid; and hereby appropriate the same for irrigation and other purposes to be used on the lands embraced in said section five.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that on the 30th day of December A.D. 1885, I, - E. G. Stevenson, then of the County of Storey and State aforesaid, and owner of all of Section 5 in township 16 North, Range 20 East M.D.B. & M., containing 640 acres of land, and situate in said County of Washoe, did appropriate, for irrigation and other purposes, all the waters of a certain stream flowing from near the dividing line between sections 2 & 11 in said township and range, and running northwesterly and westerly through sections 2-3-4-5 and recorded on page 353 in Book B. of surveys and records of Washoe County, Nevada; That I have constructed and maintained a ditch and flume known as the "Stevenson Ditch and Flume," as shown by the annexed plat, which is made a part hereof, diverting the waters of said stream at a point near the center of the N.W. 1/4 of section 4, thence westerly along the south side of said stream onto the land embraced in said section 5, under the provisions of the Act of the Legislature of the St. of Nev., approved Mar. 3, 1866, entitled "An Act to allow any person or persons to divert the waters of any river or stream," My present P.O. address is Carson City, Nevada.
