Remarks: Several Troughs with pipe laid to them have been built at Gann Spring in an attempt to get permanent water. During the winter months if a wet year an irrigating stream will flow, only to dry up completely by summer time. Floods have taken out several troughs. At present there is 200 ft. of pipe leading to the trough 4 x 14 x 22 ft.

Remarks: The water from Gann Spring has been the ^{main} source of water for stock during the winter months since cattle were first run on the Gold Butte range. Our predecessors in interest, Sam Gentry and Geo. D. Hartman, first used it in 1903. In the early '20's my cattle watered there. In the late '20's & early '30's skinnants watered sheep here. At present our lessee, D. D. Mason is using it. ^{has since 1945} From 1933 until 1941 we leased to local cattlemen
