PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

Laura Gensby, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by herself, A.S. & E.F. Mc Gougle, her associates are full and correct to the best of ~~his~~ knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is 25 ft. pipe  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 4' x 10' x 20" Trough  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1917  
and completed 1917

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is grazing privilege on Public Domain as governed administered by Nevada State & Water Law

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Clark County, at Page 268-269 of Book 12 of Deeds

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 15, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months Jan, Feb, March, April, May

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been.....

(10) The water is diverted from its source at R.S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 feet from  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Unsurveyed

(11) The works are located at S.W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 Sec. 18 T. 18S R. 70 E.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Liston is what we call a wet weather  
spring. During wet seasons stock  
can water there without the trough  
Upon deciding to make the spring  
serviceable area a holding pasture for  
weaned San Geronimo put a trough  
& short pipe line in. Same did not  
prove practical and stock this day  
water there only during the wet season  
but not out of the trough. Throughout the  
time of the use of this water there has been but 2.5 ft. of pipe  
Ref: "Trough of Lp." for Pearson  
Spring under "Remarks"

Remarks: laid to the 4x10'x20" trough, water is there only during the winter months or if a wet year in the spring. This water was used by Sam Gendry's cattle prior to 1905 - even though no trough was built until 1917. His cattle - those of Geo. D. Hartman's, my own & those belonging to cattlemen to whom we have leased have watered there throughout the years since.
