Remarks: Cattle watered at this spring without any improvements being made until such time as a pipe line & trough was put in. The serviceable area from the spring was fenced off for a holding pasture and the improvement of the water was attempted. However, the water does not improve and stock still continue to water from the small stream that flows down the slope during the fall & winter months. During the spring & summer it dries up completely.

The pipe line is 300 ft long. The trough is 4'x10'x2.0". As the spring dries up and the water level lowers the cattle do not water here at all.

Even though no improvements were made at this
spring until 1918 Sam Gentry's cattle watered here during
the winter months not since 1903 as later did Geo. D.
Hastman's, those of my own and those of local
settlers, elements traced to the latter during the
years from 1934 to 1941. Our lessee at present, D. D. Garrison
waters cattle there and has
since 1943. Sam Gentry
