(2) The means of diversion employed is 40 ft. pipe  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 4' x 14' x 22" Trough  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1905  
and completed 1905

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is grazing privilege on Public Domain as administered by Nevada State Water Law governed

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Clark County, at Page 268-269 of Book 12 of Deeds

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 20, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months Dec - Jan - Feb - March, April

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

(11) The works are located at SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 22 T. 19.5 R. 69 E

Remarks: Ref: "Proof of App." for Pearson Spring - under "Remarks"

In most years of normal rainfall water will flow from this spring down the canyon 1/4 of a mile in the spring time.

The concrete trough of 4' x 14' x 22' diam. is fed by 40 ft. of 1 inch pipe.

Sam Gentry used the waters of this spring in 1903 and did so until he sold to H. D. Hartman in 1922. Claimants watered 2000 head of sheep here in the years 1922-23, 1924-25, 1926-27, 1931. From 1933 to '41

Remarks: They leased water to local settlement & Utah sheep  
ranch. D. D. Morrison, my personal friend, located  
some of his cattle here in 1943
