In 1903 Sam Gendry's cattle first
watered here. Until 1922 when he sold
to Geo. D. Hartman they continued to use
the water. Hartman made good use of it until 1924.

I had cattle watering here from 1916
to 1927. Since 1933 claimants have been
watering from this spring to local bottom, until
1941. In 1943 D. D. Mason, present owner,
started to use the water.
