and Elizabeth Rabe are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 200 acres.

(16) The water claimed has (~~been~~) been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were _____

(18) The claimant's water right was (~~not~~) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Douglas County, said record being at pages 67-70 of Book B of Ditch and Water Rights Springs, and being a claim for all the flow of Burk Creek and Folsom / of water for the irrigation of 400 acres of land in the following legal subdivisions: Portions of Sections 22 and 23, T. 13 N., R. 18 E.

Note—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (19)

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic and stock-watering purposes for 300 head of cattle

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 2 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Reference of made to proof of appropriation 01465, filed in 1916, for water of Burk Creek and Folsom Springs, and to application 10312, made to fix point of diversion, manner and place of use of 0.05 c.f.s. of water from Folsom Springs onto portions of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22 T. 13 N., R. 18 E. during period April 1st to October 31st, by conveying it through 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch pipe to the camp ground and area originally irrigated by ditch under Proof 01465.

The water claimed under these separate proofs on Burk Creek and tributaries and Folsom Springs has been continuously used during the irrigation season commencing about April 1st and ending about October 31st -- and intermittently used (weather permitting) in the period October 31st to April 1st of the following year for irrigation, soil water storage, stock water for 300 head of cattle, and for domestic purposes since 1861.

The waters of Burk Creek and its tributaries have been divided by ditches and dams in the main channel of the creek; the upper meadow has been and is being irrigated by using the main channel, starting at a point which bears N. 42°20' E 3530 feet from the SW Cor. Sec. 23 T 13 N R 18 E and which point bears S. 89°20'42" E 2377.40 feet from the quarter corner of Sections 22 and 23 T 13 N R 18 E.

A portion of the upper meadow and a portion of the lower meadow have been irrigated by ditch, starting at a point on Burk Creek which bears N. 44° E 2260 feet from the SW Cor. Sec. 23 T 13 N R 18 E and S. 57°13'10" E. 1867.2 feet from the quarter corner of Sections 22 and 23 T 13 N R 18 E.

The lower meadow has been irrigated, and is being irrigated, by the co-mingled waters of Burk Creek and Folsom Spring and tributaries - the latter water being diverted from the spring into ditches at a point which bears N, 1°31' E 1857 feet from the SW Cor. Sec. 23 T 13 N R 18 E. The waters of Burk Creek and Folsom Spring and tributaries have been co-mingled and used beneficially in the most economical manner possible. There are no other users on the source.
