

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by George N. Dierenger and S. F. Bowler are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Natural use by livestock. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in. Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and completed used in place from Bowler Ranch beginning in 1864 and from Dierenger Ranch in 1885.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 525, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days during each of the following months Year long in varying numbers.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Approx out half of the cattle operated from the Dierenger and Bowler ranches
are believed to have used these waters with regularity throughout the
year. There would naturally be some variation in use in different seasons
and different years. Use has continued from these ranches to the present date.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been.....

at spring in S ESE
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
