(21) The character of the soil is Sandy Loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 0.5 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 12 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.


(22) Remarks: This Spring has been active prior to 1913, and the diverted water is shown upon a map prepared by Chas. E. Sexton on April 3, 1919. Water flows through ditches and mingled with other water from Wells and Springs situate upon the land owned by the applicant and claimant. Currently the flow is approximately 75 gal/min. The source and point of diversion for this <sup>SOUTH</sup> ~~North~~ Spring is, situate within NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 15, T 20 S, R 53 E, MD.M. or at a point from which the East  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Sec. 15 bears North 52°30' East a distance of 1590 feet. Prior to 1940, this South Spring flowed approx. 150 gal/min.
