(21) The character of the soil is (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Claimant diverts all of the available flow in Hobart Creek into the two parallel transmission lines described herein at the diversions indicated on the accompanying map. Diversion at each flume is five second feet. Water is diverted from its source at the following points: Upper point of diversion: NE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., N.D.P.M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32 bears S. 68° 08' E., 2,674 feet. Lower point of diversion: NE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., N.D.P.M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32 bears S. 55° 18' E., 1,531 feet.
