(21.) The character of the soil is Sandy and gravelly The soil needs acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Buck Station was a Stage Station in the early 1880's and has since been developed by the diversion of Stonehouse Creek (Buck Spring No. 2) to the irrigated lands on the West Bench below the house. Irrigation was first developed by Italians between 1880 and 1883 (Minoletti and Ganduglia) (to in 1912) prior to its ownership by W. A. Moore in about 1917 and its subsequent purchase by Pete and Julian Goicoechea in 1941. 225 tons of alfalfa and a stack of approximately 25 tons of unthrashed grain and 20 tons of potatoes were raised the year that Ganduglia sold Buck Station to W. A. Moore. Much of the natural spring water however is lost in the gravel ditches along the benches to the Ranch, plans are being formulated to save this loss and redevelop the ranch to a productivity even greater than that of 1917.
