(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: cemetery use & adornment

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam The soil needs -- acre-feet  
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)  
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 0.05 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 12 months, is needed for cemetery use

(22) Remarks: The estimated flow of the spring by the undersigned is 0.05 cfs.  
Capital Lodge No. 20, I.O.O.F. listed as a co-partner has surrendered charter and assets to the Grand Lodge; therefore, the Grand Lodge transferred the interest in the water rite to Carson Lodge No. 4, I.O.O.F. and at same time changed name to Capital Lodge No. 4. All information on this form was gathered from a study of the Records of the Lodges involved, and the Ormsby County records.

The point of diversion of water claimed is located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 11, T. 15N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said section 11 bears N. 09°49'E., a distance of 1091.65 feet.
