(2) The means of diversion employed is well pressure system and pipe lines
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in troughs and pressure tank

and completed prior to 1913

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 13 N., R. 19 E.
M.D.B. & M Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Artesian Well C is drilled to a depth of 180 feet with a 3 inch casing, and the water is delivered to points that are numbered on the supporting map.

(1) A 1 1/4 inch pipeline connects with a pump and pressure system located in the Milking barn. This system is also hooked up with Artesian Well A. and the combined supply of water serves the needs of the Milking Barn and a Trailer house. (C-14 and A-14.)

(2) C - 16 :- 12 feet of 3 inch pipe conveys the water to a concrete trough that is 2 feet wide, 2 feet deep and 50 feet long. This water serves the dairy cow night time corral and the northern end serves the calf pen.

(3) (C - 17 :- A 1 1/4 inch pipe line conveys water in a southerly direction to a ten foot semi-circular metal trough, that serves 3 corrals.


