


THE STATE OF NEVADA  
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR  
STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From King's River  
Name of natural water course

Pete Yrueta, the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by  
Pete Yrueta are full and correct to the  
best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is: sheep are watered directly from King's River  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in direct watering from King's River  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun.....

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is by purchase  
and owned in fee simple.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Prior to 1902 - Ike Choate reported living on this property .....  
 1902-1910 Martin Legarza, Sr. & Cesario Erquiaga had 2 bands of sheep  
 (approx. 1000 head sheep per band)  
 1910-1933 Bentura Bengocheas also had 2 bands of sheep .....  
 1933-1952 Mike Goyhex leased property/ had two bands of sheep.....  
 1952-1960 Pete Yrueta had two bands of sheep .....  
 1960-1961 Pete Yrueta had one band of sheep.....  
 1961-1963 Pete Yrueta has no sheep on property because of economic  
 reasons.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

the northeast corner of Section 19, T. 47 N., R. 33 E.,
