(21) Remarks: I have acquired complete title to this land in June, 1963 from E. S. Bowman, first recorded in Clark County in September, 1943. I also have a 1/4 interest in application #6578, Ford Spring, certificate #1379. This 10 acres has been fenced since 1905.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by F. W. Thorne are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.
