

(20) Remarks. Proof 02533 was originally filed by Harry H. Ormesher and Harold Lake in 1964. Said Proof made a claim for the irrigation of 85 acres from Lockes Spring (Also known as Big Spring). Said Proof did not fully describe the extent of the lands irrigated which included both Patented and Public lands. Based on research of the Historical Record, Field Investigations, and Affidavits, the extent of the use of the waters of Lockes Spring, when co-mingled with the waters of other springs and seeps on the ranch, covers a total of 1900 acres. This Amended Proof is being filed to reflect the full extent of the vesting of this right.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Harry H. Ormesher and Harold Lake are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Deponent is an employee of Thiel Engineering Consultants (TEC). TEC has been hired by Roy Hall, Successor in interest to the original claimants, to file this Amended Proof.


