feet, width on top 3 feet, depth 1 feet, on a grade of 2 1/2 feet per thousand feet.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 20 acres.

(16) The water claimed ~~has~~ has not been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated. Strike out one not wanted

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were Active irrigation to 1934 and used as pasture since that time. Heavy spring run-offs in Leonard Creek cause extensive damage to ponds of diversion with heavy expense to replace each year.  
If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given, appending a sheet of necessary

(19) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Pasture

(20) The character of the soil is Loam The soil needs 4 acre-feet  
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)  
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2.2 cubic feet of water per  
second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: Application and permit No. 6426 was made to cover any lands not included in Proof No. 01683 although the lands were cultivated prior to the time of Application and Permit No. 6426.

An error by the surveyor in omitting the point of diversion and the short irrigation ditch in the SE1/4 NE1/4 Section 13, T. 42 N., R. 28 E., MDB&M shown on the cultural map under Proof No. 01683 but not shown on the cultural map to support the Proof of Beneficial Use under Application and Permit No. 6426 apparently has prevented a certificate from being issued to the lands embraced under this Proof of Appropriation.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Pine Forest Land and Stock Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.
