(19) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stockwatering and Domestic

(20) The character of the soil is Loam The soil needs 4 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: This water has been in continuous use by appropriators since July 7, 1883. Water is comingled with water from Stone Cabin Springs located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 8, T. 4 N., R. 48 E., M. D. M.


