

(19) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock watering

(20) The character of the soil is sandy loam The soil needs 6 acre-feet
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2 1/2 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks:
