2. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 2 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36 bears S. 62° 00' E. - 2,478 feet.
3. SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T.2 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36 bears S. 11° 30' E. - 5,702 feet.

Claim is also made for livestock watering for Frank Seminario, Inc. which has, as in the case of all of its predecessors in interest, used the subject area for livestock grazing. The area is within the Bureau of Land Management and Forest Service allotment to the ranch of Frank Seminario, Inc. and its cattle water there. Claim is made for 100 head of cattle, which is the traditional number watered in that area from these same water sources.

Map to support this Proof is same as map filed to prove vested right for Trail Creek and tributaries. Points of diversion and waters are set forth on those maps.
