(20) The character of the soil is sandy The soil needs 6 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2.5 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 8 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: Major continuous flow is from Van Sickle dam and reservoir
