(19) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock water and domestic use.

(20) The character of the soil is Sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 240 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 2.5 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: The main source of continuous flow is from the Van Sicle Dam and Reservoir (Originally Haines Dam and Reservoir).

The claimant has a right to one seventh of the water of Daggett Creek which is being divided on a time of use basis rather than a continuous flow basis.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by F. H. Ruppel are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant
