

(20) The character of the soil is Gravelly Loam The soil needs 4 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.0 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: Ranch is now irrigated by portable sprinkler system and ditches.  
Acreage irrigated in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec 16, T 39 N, R 70 E, is on public domain and has the same priority as adjacent deeded lands.
