(17) Residence has not been maintained on this land since 1933 and consequently the irrigated fields were not maintained. Claimants, however, did not abandon their vested irrigation rights and as pointed out, there has been a continuous stockwater use from these sources.

(19) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stockwater (90 head of stock and 5 horses) and domestic

(20) The character of the soil is gravelly (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 4.5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.26 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: The Greens predecessor in interest was Guy Tachino who perfected a Homestead on the subject land. Prior to filing the Homestead application on September 12, 1910 the Tachinos and their predecessors in interest used this land in conjunction with their ranching operations on the W 1/2 of NE 1/4 of Section 16, T. 16 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M. maintaining pasture, stockwatering and domestic facilities with water from the above referenced sources - all prior to 1905.

The W 1/2 of NE 1/4, Section 16 was purchased from the State of Nevada by Charles Gaillard June 7, 1875 (Secretary of State Records Vol. 2, page 272) and deeded to Giovanni Tulfo and Calerina Tachino June 7, 1875 (Washoe County Records Book 5, page 510). Use of this and the contiguous Green parcel for pasture, stock-water as domestic has been maintained since that date.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by them are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant
