(20) The character of the soil is sandy loam The soil needs 4 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.12 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(21) Remarks: The courthouse in White Pine County was destroyed by fire on January 1, 1885 and all records were lost.  
Official field notes of the Public Land Surveys of T. 19 N., R. 66 E., dated 1872, call out O'Neil's house, meadow areas and good grass in Section 25.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by B. H. Robison are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.
