(19) The character of the soil is sandy loam 4 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate acres of land.
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)

(20) Remarks: Included with the Proof of Appropriation are certified copies of affidavits of Annie Tennille Dawson and Jewell Martin stating that the land was irrigated prior to 1902, also there are affidavits by Wyona Olin, and Samuel Baker now on record in the Office of State Engineer filed under Application 1841. The clients water rights were only partially covered by recorded application 1841-1842, Book 3, pages 169-170 State Engineers Office and that is the reason for filing this Proof of Appropriation.


