On June 18, 1929, Application 8960 was filed in the Office of the State Engineer and was approved on May 7, 1930, for 6.65 CFS of water from an underground source to irrigate the lands described under Item 13. 3. The subject well was drilled and water placed to Beneficial Use prior to and continuously since March 25, 1939, on the lands described under Item 13, therefore a claim of a vested underground water right is herein made. 4. To the best of our knowledge the subject well pumps water from underground "percolating waters", the course and boundaries of which are incapable of determination. 5. At times, this well is the only source of water on lands described in or on question 13.




