(20) Remarks: The system has been in continuous use serving the J. S. Bar Ranch since before 1885. The diversion works consist of a catch basin 2' x 2' x 6' and pipeline approximately 1700 feet in length to a 1650 gallon storage tank located at the main ranch house. The water is used for domestic purposes for 3 houses. The excess is used to water stock and to irrigate two acres of lawns, garden, fruit trees, and a hay field. An application for a permit to appropriate public waters was filed May 16, 1974. See map accompanying application no. 28337. Place of use is NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T16N, R19E, M.D.B. & M.
