1880 - at least 1500 Sheep, 115 Cattle, 51 Horses; 1885 - at least 1850 sheep, 315 Cattle, 169 Horses; 1895 - at least 5500 Sheep 375 Cattle, 121 Horses. This use has been continuous to the modern era. ELLCo and its predecessors utilize this same spring with the equivalent of up to 1870 cattle on a combination of private and public land, this spring being a part of the larger operation.

Remarks

The first use of this water for livestock was in 1849 when a branch of the California Trail passed through the area. Numbers are difficult to establish but they would have been significant, and commensurate with the well documented uses that began in 1873 (E.C. Hardy homestead file). These uses, in turn, comport very well with the modern livestock numbers (grazing permits for 1100 to 1584, plus more livestock on private land).

This spring is used in conjunction with the Big Springs Ranch and Hardy Creek operations described in other Proofs.




