Remarks The Range Unit covered by Proofs of Appropriation, filed in June 1981, on Page, Hulse, Wilson, Rosecrans, Millard, Wood McCullough and other water sources in the Mount Wilson Area is well documented by early Proofs filed by Murray Sheep Company and the land is documented by Abstract No. 1362 referred to in detail on the following page. This Abstract presents an easy reference to the chain of Land Title and related water use rights from 1920 to 1980 and in essence fortifies the use claimed by Murray Sheep Company from the 1870's, 1880's and 1890's to the 1920's.

Remarks. The Claimant herein, Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Company, Inc., has filed with the State Engineer a certified copy of Abstract No. 1362 by Dominick Belingheri, comprising 183 entries on 77 pages dated October 1, 1980, which exhibit outlines the Claimant's right to lands in the vicinity of this Proof.


