(19) The character of the soil is sandy loam A continuous flow of 4.595\*\* cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 190.8 acres of land and 5 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

(20) Remarks: \*\* Flow has always been variable from spring to summer.  
Additionally, water flow has decreased considerably since the construction of Echo Dam. This dam stops all flow down the wash and holds it until it sinks into the underground basin. The water table in Dry Valley where Echo dam is located has been coming up since the dam was put in.

A portion of this water coming down Meadow Valley Wash in Condor Canyon was proved in Lincoln County District Court Decree: C.P. Ronnow, Charles Mathews, William Mathews, and Phillip Mathews, Plaintiffs vs. Joseph Delmue and Marcellus Delmue, Defendants. (Copy enclosed)


