MILLING & DOMESTIC PURPOSES

- 1) Name of Claimant: The Wolfram Company

- 2) Source of water: Underground
- 3) The water is diverted from its source at the following point: within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 5, T.25N., R.30E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 5, T.25N., R.30E., M.D.B. & M. bears S 19 degrees 31 minutes W 2087.4'.
- 4) The means of diversion employed: drilled well, pump, motor, water tower, and storage tank.
- 5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the source of water and place of use are located is patented portions of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, T.25N., R.30E., M.D.B. & M.
- 6) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been 0.66 cubic feet per second.

Remarks: This water was used at the existing Toulon mill at Toulon, Nevada. Water was used to process ore in a 140 ton per day milling operation that ran 24 hours per day, year round. In addition, water was provided to two residences, a bunkhouse and a fire protection system. Approximately 35 people were employed. This well was apparently constructed and used prior to 1922 (See enclosed letter from J.R. Caldwell dated 3/8/84).

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by the Wolfram Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.
