(19) The character of the soil is sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam). A continuous flow of 5.0 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 1240 acres of land and 4.5 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

(20) Remarks: This well was originally drilled some time around 1928 and was redrilled in 1945. Pumping from this has supplmented Carson River rights held by the Dangberg Ranch for the last 60 years.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Dangberg Ranch are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief. claimant is successor in interest and presnt owner of the Dangberg Ranch. If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant


