(20) Remarks: A flow measurement at the division box in March 1987 suggests that  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  of the flow of Mott Creek amounts to approximately 1.2cfs under the  
runoff conditions then prevailing. The flow diminishes, but has apparently  
never ceased, in July and August. From the above, it would appear that, on  
average, something on the order of 175-200 acre feet of water has been  
used to irrigate the lands listed in #13 above.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Stone, et al. (see #1 af attached) are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.


