(20) Remarks: During periods where the flow has dimenished, a pump was installed to deliver the water to carry on the irrigation and stock water use in the basin; the well has been pumped over 90 gpm without a significant diminishment of head; during historic periods of high flow the well had the capabilities to produce sufficient water for the historic use, present flow is somewhat less due to the drought cycle and pumpage within the area.
