No proof or evidence is found as to the use of the waters of Wiseman Creek, but to the best information and belief, the return waters have been continuously used since prior to 1905. The affidavit of Edward R. Chase referred to in Item 17 indicates a priority of at least 1880. The waters from Winchell Creek, K-G or Conway Creek and the sources specified herein are commingled. The irrigated acreage as a result of the commingling is approximately 249.37 acres of which the waters of this proof are estimated to contribute 60%. Therefore, this proof is for 149.62 acres with a priority of 1880 located within Sections 29 and 32, T. 32 N., R. 62 E., MDB&M.


