(1) Name of claimant Asamera Minerals (U.S.) Inc.

(2) Source of water Cooney Spring East.

(3) The water is diverted by a dam.

(4) The water is diverted at the following point within the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 25, T.18N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., from which point the East quarter corner of said Section 25 bears N.32°01'44"E. a distance of 684.44 feet.

(5) The water is impounded in natural channels and a reservoir.

(6) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1905 and completed prior to 1905.

(7) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the source of water and place of use are located is deeded.

(8) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of lands as rights appurtenant to the fee Storey County, at Page 41 of Book 060 of Official Records.

(10) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Within the general vicinity, bands of 2,000 or more sheep each If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given. grazed the area, tended by a shepherd with a burro or two. Additionally, teams of horses used by the camp tender were watered. Fifteen to twenty bands grazed the area each season, watering at various springs. The estimated cumulative total is thus approximately 40,000 animals watered per season within the entire region, encompassing a number of springs.

(11) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been 0.1 cubic feet per second.  
44.83 gal. per min. equals 1 cubic foot per second.


